

HANGING REQUIREMENTS

- Select clean, simple style frames in wood or metal. This is the protocol for all contemporary galleries. Use plexiglass rather than glass if possible. This is a safety request.
- Attach a durable taut wire to the back of your art piece in such a way that no hardware is visible from the front or sides. Be SURE wire is low enough to hide hanging hardware above hung piece.
- You can use D-rings or eye screws to attach your wire. Wire should be between 3 8" from the top depending on the size of your artwork.
- Make sure you cover the ends of the wire and any screw heads neatly with tape to prevent handlers
 from getting scratched and prevent damage to walls. Do not put any tape in the middle of the wire
 or it will not hang properly.
